Spartan Ten Thousand & Manley Spring Fair

RACE DETAILS

Thank you for your entry to the Spartan Ten Thousand on Monday 4 May 2015. The Race starts at 12.30pm. Registration opens at 11.00am.

The course is a fairly demanding 10km trail race in nearby Delamere Forest. The start and finish will be from the Spring Fair and will head off to the Forest along New Pale Road. Approximately 2km of the course is on quiet country lanes and 8km on trails and tracks in the forest. There will be a road closure in Manley throughout the day – in part to facilitate the race. If approaching from the A54/B5393 through Ashton Hayes and Mouldsworth please ignore the 'Road Diversion' signs and continue along the road towards Manley where you will find the Car park indicated on the map.

Toilets and basic changing facilities are available in Manley Village Hall.

All competitors will receive water, snack and 'goody bag' on completion of the race. There are extensive refreshments available at the Spring Fair including hot and cold food. There will also be a licensed bar in Manley Village Hall.

There are 3 Car Parks available for the Spring Fair and Race Competitors – see the attached diagram for details.
